HOME PASS REQUIREMENTS

1. After **THREE MONTHS (90 days)** Residents are eligible to request one 48 hour Home Pass per month if they:
 - have completed their ninety day probationary period
 - are currently employed, in school, or are volunteering
 - have attended 7 AA and/or NA meetings the week previous to pass
 - are in contact daily with a sponsor
 - are current in their financial obligations to Homestead
 - are current on all house chores and responsibilities
2. After **SIX MONTHS (180 days) Residents** are eligible to request two 48 hour Home Passes per month providing all steps listed above are in place.
3. After **NINE MONTHS (270 days)** Residents are eligible to request three 48 hour Home Passes per month providing all steps listed above are in place.
4. Home Pass request must be turned in to staff no later than the Wednesday prior to visit.
5. Resident is responsible:
 - for choosing a safe and sober environment in which to stay that is approved by the staff
 - for attending AA or NA meetings each day that they are absent from the house
 - for making daily contact with the house by calling 706.754.0102 and talking with whomever answers the phone or leaving a message.
 - to “live the program” while absent from the house and is subject to drug-screen upon return to Homestead
6. Home passes do not have to be taken on weekends, but may be taken for any 48-hour period and may also be granted in case of emergency (i.e. death, family illness).
7. Home passes may be rejected at the discretion of the staff.
8. If staff suspects questionable behavior, home pass may be revoked at any time and resident will be required to return to Homestead immediately.

Residents must be back by 5 PM unless prior agreement is made with staff.
