MEDICATION POLICY

Prior to admission, each prospective resident must supply the Program Director a complete list of all medications they are taking.

- There will be no mood-altering medications allowed.
- Each resident will administer their own medications and keep a log which will become part of their permanent record. Residents will be provided medication log sheets. The log will be reviewed by the Program Director at her discretion.
- In the event there is a situation where a resident needs to receive a narcotic or other habit forming drug, the Program Director must be informed immediately. In this instance the Program Director will communicate with a member of the Clinical Team for the proper procedure to be taken.
- If a resident is found to have acquired a drug that has not been approved, or appropriate for a Homestead resident, the resident will be asked to leave immediately. If she is on probation, the proper official will be notified.
