PROGRAM FEES

Homestead is a non-profit organization and does not receive funding from any federal, state, court, or social service programs. Operating costs are covered solely by donations, rent, and entrance fees collected.

The following are the standard fees and payment options of the Homestead Women's Recovery program. All fees for the program are due on Wednesday, for the upcoming week. **Monies paid for the week in progress are non-refundable, effective on the Wednesday on which they were paid.** All other fees are due at the time of service. Any refunds due will be returned in check form to the entity that originally provided the funds.

Monthly \$740	Due no later than the 10 th day of the month for the current month.
Bi-monthly \$370	Due no later than the 2 nd Wednesday of the month for the upcoming 2 weeks.
Weekly \$185	Due on Wednesday of each week for the upcoming week.
Daily \$26	Used to compute less than 1 week time period.

The ceiling for any debt is \$370.00. Passes will be withheld until accounts are brought up-to-date. Note past due accounts are potential grounds for dismissal from the program.

FEE STRUCTURE

Entrance Fee Requirements	\$1,500.00	Scholarships may be available – See Admission
First month rent	\$ 740.00	
Mid-month rent	\$26.00 per day	prorated for the 2 nd month.
Residential Program	\$185.00	Weekly

*As noted above, residents have the option of paying monthly, bi-monthly, or weekly

Clients are responsible for all services rendered. Homestead does NOT accept insurance. Payment must be made in the form of Cash, Money Order, or Cashier's Check. PAYPAL may also be used but must include extra funds for the processing fee. Personal Check may be accepted if advance arrangements are made with the Program Director or Business Manager. All returned checks will incur a \$25 fee. Resident must pay check amount and penalty in cash. Checks will not be processed a 2nd time.

All new residents will meet with the Business Manager during the first week of residency to submit and/or formulate a budget.
